ORDINANCE 2020- **♦**

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 91-7 "ORDINANCE PROHIBITING PUBLIC NUISANCE"

WHEREAS, the Town of Michigantown (Town) previously adopted Ordinance 91-7, as amended, prohibiting public nuisances; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of Michigantown Town Council has determined that the Town Code Enforcement Officer should be able to serve notice on the owner of the premises where such nuisance exists, and upon any other person causing such nuisance, to abate such nuisance within ten (10) days of notice, and all further notices of violations the same as the Town Marshall.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MICHIGANTOWN, INDIANA, THAT:

Section 6.

(a). In any case where any nuisance may exist, it shall be the duty of the Town Marshall or the Town Code Enforcement Officer) at the direction of the Town Council, to serve notice upon the owner of the premises where such nuisance exists, and upon any other person causing such nuisance, to abate such nuisance within ten (10) days of said notice. Following this initial notice, for further violations of the same or similar nature on the same property within twelve (12) months of the initial notice, additional notices shall be served by the Town Marshall or the Town Code Enforcement Officer upon the owner, directing the owner to abate the nuisance within twenty-four (24) hours of the notice.

The sections, paragraphs, sentences, clauses and phrases of this Ordinance are separable, and if any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph, or section of this Ordinance shall be declared unconstitutional, invalid, or unenforceable by the valid judgment or decree of a court of competent jurisdiction, such unconstitutionality or unenforceability shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs, and sections of this Ordinance.

That this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval, and publication according to law.
