AN ORDINANCE REVOKING ORDINANCE 2011-01 *SECTION 2*
CONCERNING CONNECTIONS TO THE TOWN OF
MICHIGANTOWN, INDIANA SEWAGE WORKS

WHEREAS, the Town of Michigantown (Town) previously adopted Ordinance No. 2006-1, as amended, and Ordinance No. 2011-_____ which specified how connecting to the Town sewer works allocated the costs of connecting or tapping into its sewer works; and,


WHEREAS, the Town of Michigantown Town Council has determined that Ordinance No. 2011-01 is not in the best interests of the Town and should be revoked and replaced.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF MICHIGANTOWN, INDIANA, THAT:


1. Ordinance No. 2011-01 is hereby revoked in its *SECTION 2* entirety.
2. That anyone desiring to attach a sewage line to the Town of Michigantown sewage works is responsible for the cost of bringing their line to the sewer line of the Town of Michigantown, Indiana and securing all necessary easements, or right of way grants from individuals, corporate entities, estates, the Town of Michigantown, or the State of Indiana.
3. The Town of Michigantown shall then charge a tap fee of \$50.00 plus the cost of labor, materials and overhead costs in excess of the base cost of *\$1500.00* ~~\$50.00~~.


