AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE PARKING OF TRAFFIC ON CERTAIN STREETS IN MICHIGANTOWN, CLINTON COUNTY, INDIANA.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE BOARD OD TRUSTEES OF THE TOWN OF MICHIGANTOWN CLINTON COUNTY, INDIANA, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION I

That the parking of all vehicles, whether motor vehicle or farm equipment, whether licensed or unlicensed, between Second Street on the South and Fourth Street on the North on Main Street (or State Highway 29) in the business district of Michigantown Clinton County Indiana (hereafter referred to as the designated area) is hereby limited to 48 hours continuous parking. No such vehicle shall be allowed to remain parked or stationed in said designated area for a period of more than 48 hours without being in violation of this ordinance.

SECTION II

Any vehicle parked for more than 48 hours continuously in the designated area shall be notified by the placing of a ticket or a notice on said vehicle requesting the removal of said vehicle within 24 hours. The time of said notice and the time for the removal of such vehicle shall be specified on said ticket or notice. Any vehicle remaining parked in said designated area after said 24 hour period may be towed away at the direction of the Board of Trustees of the Town of Michigantown or it's authorized agent at the expense of the owner of said vehicle. Furthermore, any owner so ticketed may be subjected to a fine for violation of said ordinance, said fine shall be not less than \$10.00 nor more than \$100.00 plus court cost and any legal expenses and fees incurred in the enforcement of this ordinance.

SECTION III

That the town marshal of Michigantown, Clinton County,

Indiana, or anyone else authorized by the Board of Trustees of
said Town, is hereby authorized and directed to regulate and

SECTION IV

This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and at the date of it's passage, approval, and publication as provided by law.
